“Statement of the National Republicans of Iran”-Goals

We, the National Republicans of Iran, believe that the time has come to stand together to save our homeland from its fundamental crisis—namely, the transition away from the repressive and criminal Islamic regime—and to support Mr. Reza Pahlavi, a credible, democratic, and internationally recognized figure. He possesses the ability and readiness necessary to guide a peaceful, orderly transition grounded in democratic principles.

The management of the transitional period is a role that is inherently temporary, limited, and solely dedicated to creating the necessary conditions for the people themselves to determine the country’s future. The primary objective of this period is to make possible the holding of a free and fair referendum, under the supervision of independent international institutions, so that the Iranian nation can freely decide the future form of the democratic government.

He is recognized inside the country and among a broad spectrum of Iranians abroad as a unifying figure—someone who has been able to bring together diverse segments of the opposition around fundamental principles in which we also believe.

We, too, come together around shared principles:

- 1. Territorial integrity of Iran**

Preserving the unity and territorial integrity of the country is a fundamental, non-negotiable principle and the central pillar of any future political and social program.

- 2. Secularism and separation of religion from the state**

To guarantee freedom of religion, freedom of conscience, and equality of all citizens before the law, the system of governance must be secular, and no religious institution should interfere in political or administrative decision-making.

- 3. Full commitment to human rights based on the Universal Declaration of Human Rights**

All fundamental freedoms—including freedom of expression, freedom of assembly, the right to choose one’s lifestyle, gender equality, and minority rights—must be guaranteed and enshrined in the future constitution.

- 4. Freedom of political parties and organizations**

Democracy has no meaning without free, fair, and equal competition among political forces. Political activity must be possible without censorship, pressure, or discrimination.

- 5. Free, fair, and transparent elections**

Elections must be conducted under the supervision of independent bodies so that people can freely choose their representatives. The future democratic system of government will be determined solely through the direct vote of the people.

- 6. Formation of a Constituent Assembly and drafting of a modern constitution**

Members of the Constituent Assembly must be elected through free elections to draft a new constitution based on democracy, human rights, and national sovereignty.

7. Rule of law and transparency in governance

All centers of power must be subject to the law. The government and public officials must act transparently, be accountable, and operate under the oversight of independent institutions.

8. Protection of minorities and respect for ethnic, linguistic, and cultural pluralism

Iran is a diverse land. The rights of all ethnic, religious, and cultural groups must be guaranteed and protected without any discrimination.
